

Barrett Township Safety Committee
October 12, 2011

A meeting of the Barrett Township Safety Committee was held on Tuesday, October 12, 2011 at the Barrett Township Municipal Building on Route 390 in Mountainhome. The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. by Shane Schratt, Chairman.

Present: Jeff Siglin, Jim Siglin, Officer William Carry, Rick Scrudato, Shane Schratt, Robbie Smith and Jeryl Rinehart.

The minutes of the September 13, 2011 meeting were reviewed. Discussion was held on correcting the minutes. Clifford Oppelt and John Seese were not present for the meeting. Robbie Smith made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected. The motion was seconded by Jim Siglin and carried. All committee members voted aye.

Shane Schratt reported that he will be inspecting and doing maintenance on the generator at the Municipal Building.

Officer William Carey reported that the police officers qualified for the hand gun, shot gun and rifle requirements. He also reported that there would be Triage Training for Mass Injuries with the Pocono Mountain Regional Ambulance on Thursday, October 13, 2011.

Jim Siglin reported on the meeting with the Emergency Management Team on Monday, September 26, 2011. They discussed coordinating the different departments and improving communications during emergency situations. They will also be meeting several times throughout the year to update the list of people who need assistance during future emergencies.

Jeff Siglin reported that the Fire Company will be doing training on vehicle rescues, pumper truck training and training with a technician from Heller Gas Company for propane fires.

Discussion was held on quarterly training programs and reports.

It was noted that the Open House at the Firehouse for Fire Prevention Week on Sunday, October 9, 2011 was a huge success. There were representatives from the Fire Department, the Police Department, the Medivac helicopter team and the Forest Crew No. 34 attending the Open House. There was also a Jaws of Life demonstration.

It was noted that there were no accidents reported.
