

Barrett Township Safety Committee

A meeting of the Barrett Township Safety Committee was held on Tuesday, June 14, 2011 at the Barrett Township Municipal Building on Route 390 in Mountainhome. The meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m. by Shane Schratt, Chairman.
